| <u>BY-LAW 13 – STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS</u> | <u>BY-LAW 8 – CLEARANCES, TRANSFERS AND PERMITS</u> |

| <p>13.1 Softball Queensland Inc (SQI) may organise and conduct State Championships each year at such times and places as are determined by the Board.</p> <p>13.1.1 State Championships shall be open to teams representing each District Association provided that all members of a District Association representative team are:-</p> <p>(a) registered with Softball Queensland Inc;</p> <p>(b) not unfinancial with any District Association;</p> <p>(c) not under suspension;</p> <p>(d) have, for the immediate six (6) months prior to the relevant State Championship, been a registered participant of the District Association they represent or are a new registration with Softball Queensland Inc or with the exception of umpires, have a Championship Release issued in accordance with the rules of their home association.</p> <p>Exceptions concerning residential relocation within the six (6) month criteria, will be considered by the Board upon receipt of written application from the District Association to which the participant is transferring.</p> <p>(e) in the case of interstate/overseas players, have forwarded a copy of a clearance/permit to the SQI Inc. office to have arrived not less than twenty-one (21) days prior to the first day of the relevant championship.</p> <p>13.1.2 Subject to the provisions of By-Law 13.1.1, the Board may permit any team representing a combination of District Associations to compete at an annual State Championship.</p> <p>13.1.3 The Board or the SQI Representative at State Championships may refuse entry to or withdraw a District Association team if it is found By-Law 13.1.1 has been breached.</p> <p>13.1.4 The Board shall be entitled to refuse permission for teams from any District Association to compete in a State Championship where that District Association is unfinancial</p> | <p>8.4 STATE CHAMPIONSHIP RELEASE</p> <p>8.4.1 A District Association which is unable to field a team entirely of persons registered with their association may request assistance for the provision of players and/or officials on a State Championship Release from other District Associations. Such request for assistance should come through the SQI office, but may go direct to a specific association. An individual person is not permitted to apply for a State Championship Release.</p> <p>8.4.2 A District Association may issue a State Championship Release for a person to participate in a State Championship for a District Association other than his/her Home Association provided that:-</p> <p>(a) the person has made him/herself available for selection in their Home Association trials and has been unsuccessful in the selection process;</p> <p>(b) the person's Home Association will not be fielding a team in the relevant State Championship;</p> <p>(c) there is agreement between both the Home Association and the District Association to which he/she is released to play;</p> <p>(d) By-Law 13.1 is adhered to.</p> <p>PLEASE NOTE: It must be stressed that the player will only be allowed to be released to play for another Association with the consent of the two Associations</p> |

| <u>Age Guidelines and Criteria</u> | | |

| Players must meet the age guidelines and criteria as described below to be eligible to participate in Underage State Championships: | | |
| <p>a) Under 14 State Championships</p> <p>Only players 11, 12 & 13 years of age, as at 31 December in the year of Championship, are permitted to compete in the Under 14 Championships</p> | <p>b) Under 16 State Championships</p> <p>Only players 13, 14 & 15 years of age, as at 31 December in the year of Championship, are permitted to compete in the Under 16 Championships</p> | <p>c) Under 18 State Championships</p> <p>Only players 14, 15, 16 & 17 years of age, as at 31 December in the year of Championship, are permitted to compete in the Under 18 Championships.</p> |
| <p>District Associations are to consider the following criteria when selecting the youngest eligible aged players in their representative teams (ie 11 year olds in the U14 State Championships, 13 year olds in the U16 State Championships and 14 year olds in the Under 18 State Championships). This is to ensure that the player can effectively compete in the relevant championship:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The maturity level of the player • The physical strength of the player • The skill level of the player • The positions to be played • The players level of game knowledge <p>Note: The parent/guardian of a player Under 18 years of age must sign the Championship Release Form, in addition to the District Associations Secretaries, in order for an underage player to participate on Championship Release to another Association.</p> | | |
