CABOOLTURE SPORTING CLUB LTD (CSC Group) – Sporting Club Membership



The Caboolture Sports Club is part of the CSC Group, a not-for-profit, member based organisation that began in the early 1990's. REQUESTS – USE OF TRAINING LIGHTS/DIAMONDS FOR TRAINING

Club Delegates & Rep Managers are required to make written request to Natasha Szathmary (Registrar – Training/Training Lights) for the use /allocation of diamonds for training and/or the use of training lights.



To activate the training lights to be switched 'on' & 'off' the Club Delegate at training sessions is to make contact with Natasha, who can remote control from her mobile. The activation of training lights is recorded for a monthly light billing accountability. If diamonds 1,4 & 5 are shared by teams/clubs under lights, it becomes the responsibility of the team or club to inform Natasha of the actual hours of use, for the billing process.
